

How to utilize this evaluation

This evaluation is a guide my husband and I used at times to assist us in mentoring others.

We copied the evaluation and sent it home with those we were teaching, leading, mentoring. We asked them to first to evaluate (the second column) each line on a continuum from 1 to 10 “10” meant they completely agreed with the statement and “1” meant they completely disagreed with the statement.

Then, after they had completed column two, we asked them to prioritize (the first column) each group of statements according to how important they felt the area was for their lives NOW with “1” standing for “if we only study one thing, this is what I would like it to be.”

This gave us a sense of what their felt needs and gifts were and also often showed us generational needs, strengths, and weaknesses.

After prayerfully processing their sheets, we would discuss possible strategies to focus on the top 1-2 areas they prioritized. Sometimes we could take them to a new level in an area but other times we were way outside of our gifting clusters!

Then we would call on the gifts of others. For example, one semester the women I was mentoring prioritized counseling so we contacted a local church that had a proven ministry in Biblical counseling. They were more than happy to teach us and pass on what they had learned from decades of partnering with God to apply His word to the hurts of humanity.
